

















# Import From Robohelp

Follow these steps to import a RoboHelp project into ProProfs.

1. Export your RoboHelp site as HTML. The files will appear as shown below.

1. Locate the files on your computer. Select all the files you want to zip. Right-click on any of the files (making sure all the files are still selected), select **Send To**, and another box will open. Click **Compressed (zipped) Folder**. A new folder with a zipper image on it will appear in the same general area (i.e., the desktop or folder in which the original item was saved). This is your new zip file/folder.

**Note:** It is recommended that you **delete** the following directories before importing: whdata, whgdata, whxdata.
